

Asher Yotzar Craft

You will need:

- Templates – mouth, tongue, eyes, nose
- Foam
- Googly eyes
- Cotton wool ball
- Fact sheet
- Scissors
- PVA glue and Pritt Stick
- Chalk

What to do:

A3 Background:

1. Colour the top 1/3 of the paper in solid chalk. Take a different colour and colour the bottom 1/3 in solid chalk.
2. Use your finger to smudge the two different colours into the middle of the paper to create a blended background.



Hand - foam

1. Trace the outline of your hand on the foam sheet. Cut out the hand shape.



Eyes – blue template

1. Cut out the eye template
2. Draw two smaller eyes onto the template.
3. Stick the googly eyes in the middle of each eye you have drawn.



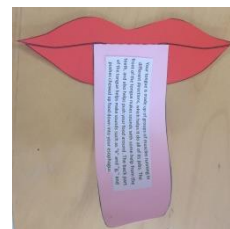
Nose – light orange template

1. Cut out the semi-circle nose template along the bold line.
2. Fold along the dotted lines, place the two outer triangular segments one on top of each other and glue them down. This will create a cone shape with a flat back.
3. Go to a staff member and spray some scent onto a piece of cotton wool.
4. Using pva glue, glue the cotton wool into the nose.



Mouth and Tongue – red and pink template

1. Cut out the tongue and mouth templates.
2. To create a curly tongue, roll up the tip of the tongue.
3. Glue the tongue onto the centre of the mouth.



PTO

Putting it all together:

1. Stick the Asher Yotzar blessing in the centre of the A3 background which you coloured with chalk earlier.
2. Cut out and stick the 'hand' title. Cut the 3 facts of your choice from the 'hand facts' and stick onto the fingers. Stick down your hand onto the A3 background.
4. Cut out and stick the 'mouth' title. Choose one or two facts about the 'mouth' and stick onto the 'tongue'. Stick your 'mouth' down.
5. Cut out and stick the 'eye' title. Fold the top ¼ of the eye template and glue onto the A3 background to create a flap. Choose three 'eye' facts and stick underneath the eye flap.
6. Cut out and stick the 'nose' title. Stick your 'nose' onto the A3 background. Stick the 'nose' facts underneath the nose.
